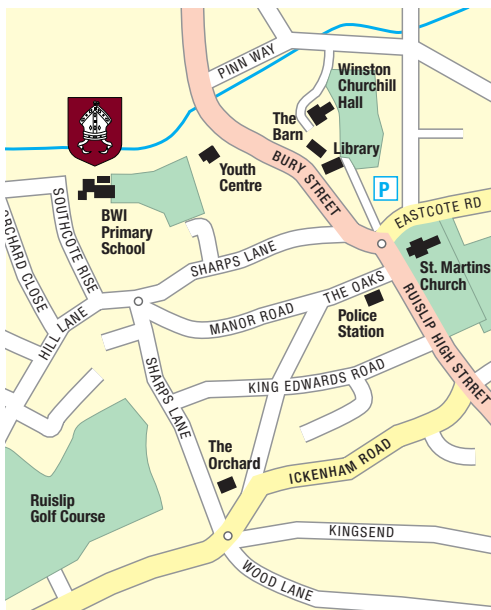


## How to apply
