






SCHOOL TRAVEL PLAN



I have been working on writing a School Travel Plan, the aims of which are identified below. The plan has been submitted to LBH School Travel Plan Co-ordinator for audit, and hopefully will then be approved by the Directors of Education and Strategic Planning to be put before Transport for London and I hope that we will then be allocated funding to help implement our plans. A working party will have to be established next term to take the Action Plan forwards.

AIMS OF OUR SCHOOL TRAVEL PLAN

-  To reduce the congestion of traffic at the front entrance to school (Southcote Rise) at the beginning and end of the school day.
-  To educate the children and parents about the importance of walking (at least part of the way) or cycling to school, thereby increasing pupil fitness levels.
-  To encourage the use of more environmentally friendly modes of transport, reducing air pollution and the consumption of fossil fuels.

-  To demonstrate a commitment to the local community to finding viable ways to reduce congestion in local roads at the beginning and end of the school day.
