Year 2 Curriculum Letter

Year 2 children will continue to explore all areas of the curriculum under a theme. The curriculum map shows how all the subjects link together.

We do hope that if you have any questions or concerns, you will feel free to pop in at the end of the school day to discuss them with us. The following information will, we hope, prove useful:

Topic: France
London

PE: Hawks – Tuesday and Thursday
Eagles – Monday and Tuesday

PE Kit: White polo shirt, black shorts, change of (white) socks, correctly fitting plimsolls, trainers, tracksuit (black trousers, maroon drill top) for outdoor games. Clothing to be kept at school.

Naming of Possessions: All items of clothing should be CLEARLY labeled with your child's forename and surname.

Please ensure your child has an art shirt in school.

Toys: Please do not allow your children to bring toys into school.

Homework: Children will be expected to read daily at home. As part of developing reading skills and independence, the children will be changing their own books. There will be a book change day once a week, if due to unforeseen circumstances your child's books are not changed on their given day there will be another opportunity during the week.

Children will have two books to read at home each week, please remember to write a comment in your child's reading log, weekly, in order to have their books changed.

Rucksacks: The cloakroom is extremely cramped. There should not normally be any need for children to bring large rucksacks. Lunch boxes are accommodated within the classroom and BWI book bags fit into the children's drawers. Your co-operation in this respect would be very much appreciated. Games kit for after-school sessions should be brought in a plastic carrier bag or designated kit bag available from the office.

It would be appreciated if your child could bring to school a plastic bottle (with a sports closure to minimize spillage), water bottles are sent home everyday for water to be changed. Water bottles are on sale at the School Office (cost £1.50). Please ensure that any bottle is named.

This year your child will undertake a series of class based assessment tasks, which will be used alongside the SATS tests. These will take place throughout the year.

Please remember to send your child to school in an appropriate coat with hat, gloves and scarf as the children go outside to play twice a day.
